## MANGKUNEGARAN PALACE

Mangkunegaran is a small Javanese princely state located within the region of Surakarta city in Indonesia. The palace of the rulers of Mangkunegaran was established by "Raden Mas Said" who signed a treaty with the Dutch East India Company (VOC) in 1757.



## JAVANESE DANCE

Mangkunegaran cultural dance as part of Javanese dance is an art that has noble values. Mangkunegaran cultural dance contained local wisdom values related to cultural identity, self identity, and philosophical meaning for human life



## KARAWITAN

Musical art that offers the beauty of sound that is so subtle and has aesthetic functions that are loaded with social, moral and spiritual values. Javanese Karawitan was created by harmonizing the complexity of the Slendro and Pelog sounds from a set of Javanese Traditional Music instruments, Gamelan.

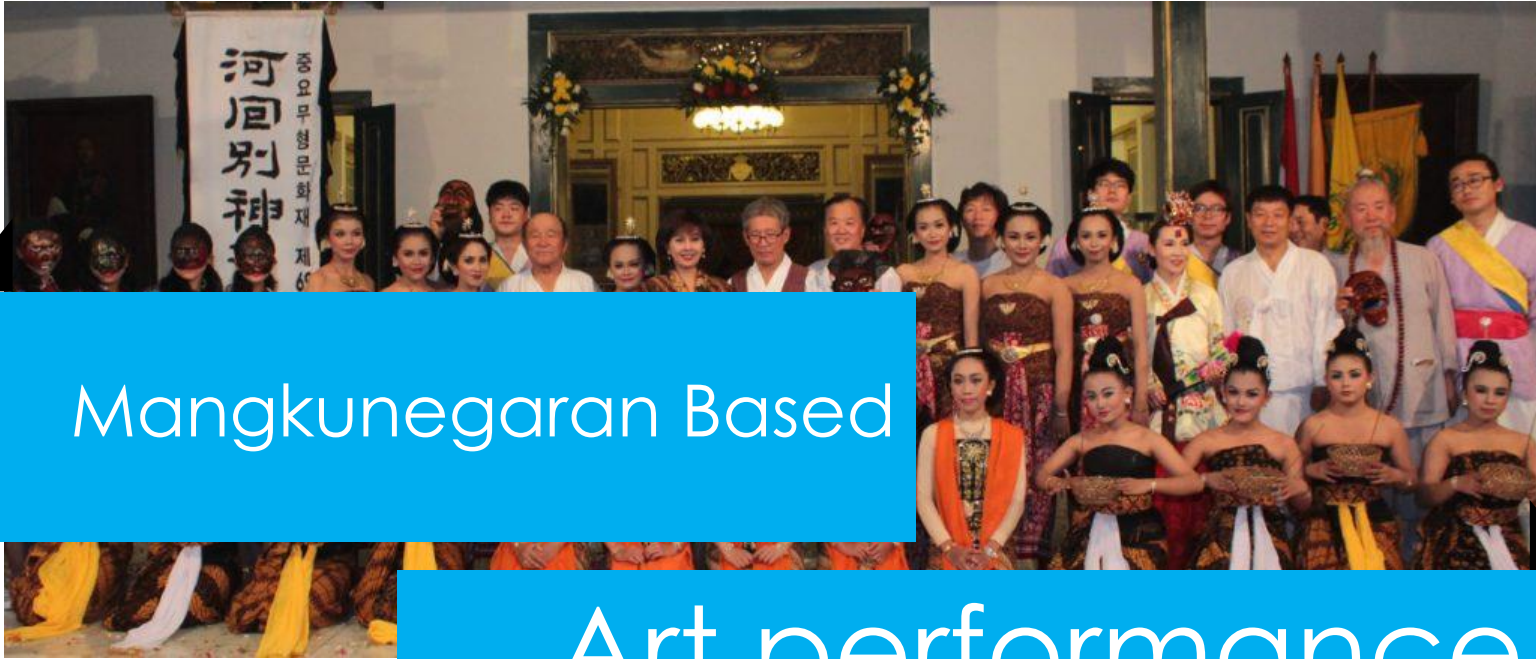

# Art performance

Indonesia is a pluralistic nation consisting of various ethnic groups, religions and languages. This plurality becomes a unity as a nation. Indonesia is a big country with a variety of diversity.

Geographically, Indonesia's area is more than 1.9 million km<sup>2</sup>. More than 17.000 islands with around 16.056 islands have their names in the United Nations. More than 650 local languages in all regions in Indonesia with Indonesian as the main language. More than 700 ethnic groups, and thousands of cultural works.

Surakarta is a city in the area of Central Java Province which has a noble culture. Surakarta, or sometimes called solo, has many characteristics, for example the Kirab tradition, historical antiques, solo batik motifs, culinary specialties, ethnic dance, ethnic music, and the kingdom area.

Mangkunegara is an autonomous kingdom that had ruled in the Surakarta region from 1757 to 1946. Akademi Seni Mangkunegaran Surakarta (ASGA) is one of the Arts Colleges managed by the Mangkunagaran Foundation. ASGA Surakarta's standing background is because of the tradition of their members in the past. Specially, the Swapraja community members of the Puro Mangkunagaran region.

The masters at Puro Mangkunagaran in the past mastered cultural fields such as fashion art, bridal make-up, protocols, Pedalangan, musical arts, dance and theater arts
